Ranger 177TR



JUST LIKE ITS FOUNDER, Forrest L. Wood, Ranger Boats has developed an iconic place among anglers in the last 40 years. With a devotion to producing the best bass-fishing boats in the industry, Wood and Ranger have come a long way since early snub-nose fiberglass boats hit the market.

Among those boats was the TR series from Ranger, perhaps most widely recalled from photos of Wood in a TR with the words “Ranger Man” lettered on the side. Today, the TR series is making a return with the Ranger 177TR. It features modern luxuries like Lowrance electronics and a Minn Kota trolling motor, but retains the classic appearance of the original TR.

Total length is 17 feet, 7 inches, and it is rated for a 115-horsepower outboard. The 177TR is a single-console model with custom marine upholstery, carpet and large storage compartments capable of holding rods up to 7 feet long. It is available in a 40th-anniversary color scheme and is dressed with 40th-anniversary badges.
